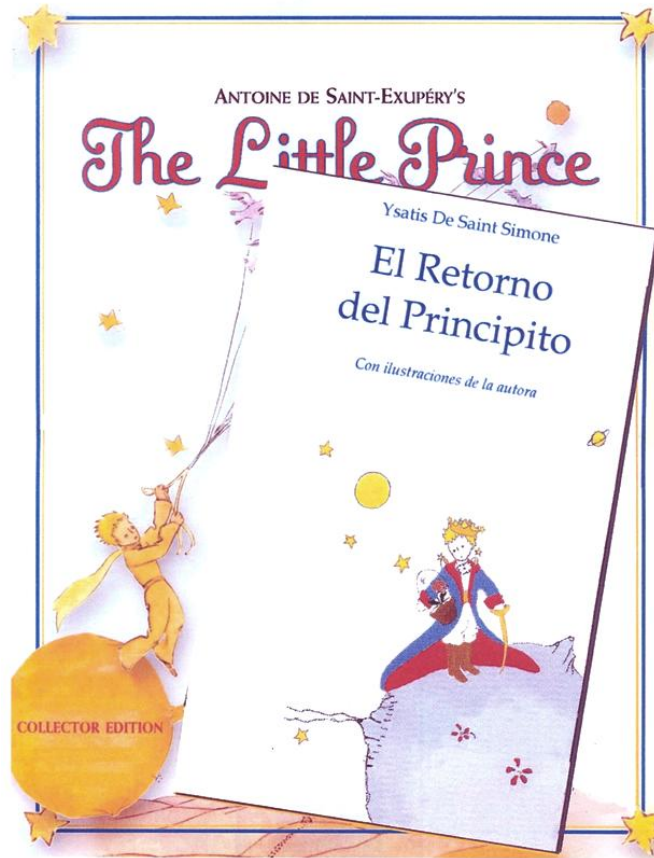

Aunt Consuelo was widowed from the well-known writer and Ambassador of Argentina in Paris, Enrique Gomez Carrillo, before marrying De Saint-Exupery. He met her in Argentina, where she was taking care of her late husband's legacy.

Aunt Consuelo, 'The Rose' of **The Little Prince** was herself an accomplished artist, painter, sculptor and a writer, who was an integral part of my intellectual and social life, and indeed a great influence in my spiritual development. She was an extraordinary person who made me part of her fantastic and inspirational world awakening in me with her story telling about life a spirit of curiosity that probes deeply into things to find the mystery hidden in them and an unlimited and magical imagination. Saint-Ex called Aunt Consuelo '*Ma sorciere et ma Muse*' he repeatedly said, '*She is my enchantress and my inspiration, my Muse, without whom I could not have written a word.*' People, who knew them well, know that's how it was. In this case, the saying, '*Behind a famous man, there's always a great woman*' is one hundred per cent correct.
